



ASSISI Centre Access Control Security System Defaults.

Overview.

This template will be used as the default system setup on the access control system for the ASSISI Centre building. This template represents the final setup for handover. **Please note:** Due to the complexity of an access control security system, the installer reserves the right to change any defaults without notice.

Access Groups.

There will be One (1) access group to control movement through the building.

Group One.

This group will have 24/7 access allowable through a successful PIN number on any keypad.

Group One will have default access to ALL areas and floors in the system

Access Points.

External Entry / Exit Points. An External Entry / Exit point represents an access point into and out of the building. Points can include Gates and doors as set by the scope of works. By Default all Entry / Exit points will require an authorised PIN code entry to gain access into the associated area. An authorised user will be programmed as a Group One as per above.

Internal Entry / Exit Points. An Internal Entry / Exit point represents any internal access point controlled by the access control system for movement inside the building. By Default all Entry / Exit points will require an authorised PIN code entry to gain access into the associated area. An authorised user will be programmed as a 'Group One' as per above.

Time Schedules.

A time schedule can be used to control various system functions within the access control system. As no instructions have been given there are no set time schedules.
